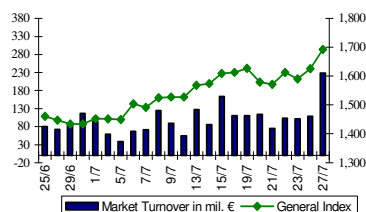

Market Comment

Greek stocks soared on Tuesday and primarily the banking sector, while traded volume more than doubled. The General Index ended at 1692.35, up by 4.13% and traded volume was at 227.84 million euros. Most up stocks: ATE Bank 1.22 euros (+15.09%), Piraeus Bank 5.14 euros (+11.98%), Alpha Bank 6.01 euros (+11.30%), Eurobank 6.63 euros (+10.50%) and Hellenic Postbank 4.28 euros (+9.74%). The 10-year Greek bond yielded 10.28 pct, down from 10.36 pct on Monday. Market seems enthusiastic and positive mood is expected to continue today.

Corporate

Alpha Bank/ The Bank said it issued a EUR1 billion covered bond on 23.7.2010 as part of its recently established EUR8 billion direct issuance covered bond programme. The bond was listed in Luxemburg Stock Exchange and was rated A by Fitch and Baa3 by Moody's and it may be pledged with the European Central Bank as collateral for liquidity purposes, hence enhancing its the bank's liquidity position.

Other

Fewer restrictions were proposed for the Basel III agreement regarding proposed measures for bank liquidity and capital. In particular, it was agreed that specific assets such as minorities to be included as capital.

Ziraat Bank dismissed earlier press reports and said it is not interested in buying a stake in ATE Bank. At the same time Marfin Bank announced that it is not aware of any interest expressed from the part of ING.



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
