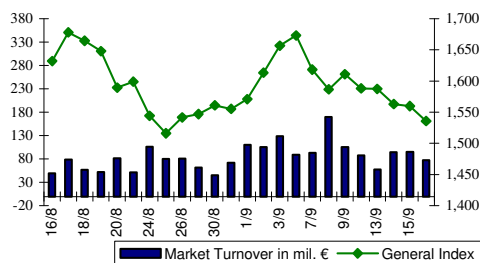

Market Comment

Athens Composite Index ended 1.55% lower yesterday at 1,535.83. Volume was at 77.19m euros. Most up stocks: Marfin Bank 1.67 euros (+6.37%), MIG 0.92 euros (+2.22%). Most down stocks: OTE 5.55 euros (-4.31%), Coca Cola Hellas 19.00 euros (-4.04%), OPAP 11.50 euros (-2.95%). The 10- year benchmark bond was the most heavily traded security of the day, with a turnover of 16 million euros. The yield spread between the 10-year Greek and German benchmark bonds rose slightly to 9.07 pct with the Greek bond yielding 11.54 pct and the German Bund 2.47 pct. Options and futures expiration.
